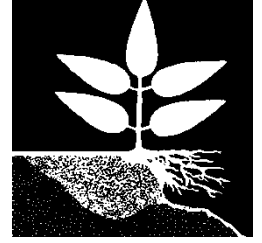




Soil Erosion Research under a Changing Climate
